Fees effective from 1st September 2025:

Our nursery school opening hours are 8:30am to 3:30pm Monday to Thursday, and 8:30am to 12:00pm on Friday.

We are open during term time only, for 33 weeks each year.

Our fees are calculated to take this into account, and reflect a full year divided by three, so you will pay the same amount each term.

Our fees are reviewed each year in line with changes to operational costs.

^{*}Please note, our attendance schedule each week does not cover your full 30 hours entitlement, if eligible, due to our shorter 'school day' model. Any remaining entitlement can be used with another provider, should you wish.

^The fourth afternoon price is reduced to £450 per term, when taking this option.

A place at our nursery is subject to payment of our non-refundable registration fee of £250. A £2,000 deposit is also required upon acceptance of your child's place and is returned to you when they leave the nursery, provided the correct notice has been given.

Government funding only covers the cost of the provision of childcare and the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

The funding does not include any of the other services that our nurseries provide, which include, but are not limited to:

- Meals and snacks
- Nappies, formula and consumables
- Additional hours
- Early starts or late finishes
- Enrichment or extracurricular activities
- Forest School
- Administration costs
- Access to our parent app
- As well as all those little extras that make our nurseries so special!

We therefore ask parents to pay for these with our consumables charge, called an 'Extras and Essentials' fee, during funded hours. This ensures that the quality of care





and service we offer is protected for all our children and parents. Details on how our fees are structured can be found at www.missdaisysnursery.com.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Extras and Essentials / Additional Services Fee:

Whilst this charge remains voluntary, if parents refuse or are unable to the pay the 'Extras and Essentials' fee, then they will need to speak to our Admissions Manager to discuss further. There is both an operational and financial impact on the nursery when this is not paid.

We do offer Fully Funded, or Funded Entitlement Only (FEO) places which are subject to availability and offered in a set booking pattern. Access to these places is determined based on need and in line with our Government Funding Policy. Please visit our website at www.missdaisysnursery.com for more information.

Giving notice on your child's place:

Notice of the withdrawal of a pupil must be given via email to your Nursery Manager and our Admissions Manager, with at least one terms' notice prior to the expected leave date.

Please note, where a Fully Funded place is accessed for your child, the notice period shall be reduced to four weeks.

Tax-free childcare:

Tax-free childcare is a method of paying for childcare costs such as nursery fees and provides a significant saving each month. It can be used alongside both 15 and 30 hours of funding.

We accept tax-free childcare as a payment method at all of our nurseries. You will first need to apply for tax-free childcare at https://www.gov.uk/tax-free-childcare

Childcare vouchers:

For those that receive childcare vouchers, we accept most of the major providers. Please contact our Admissions Manager to discuss the current scheme you are using.
