

Nursery School Fees Hyde Park

Academic Year 2026 to July 2027

Registration Fee (non-refundable) £250
Nursery Deposit £2,000.

Please note, the fees above are not required for children accessing their funded entitlement only. In all other cases, the Deposit is refundable and returned to you when the required notice is given for your child to leave the nursery. Please see our Parent Terms and Conditions for further information.

Nursery School Sessions:

Morning (AM) Sessions run from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm
Afternoon (PM) Sessions run from 12:00 pm to 3:30 pm
Full Day (FD) Sessions run from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm

All of our nursery schools close at 12:30 pm on Fridays

Late Collection:

£20.00 per every fifteen minutes of lateness after your child's expected collection time.
The fee applies at any point in each fifteen minutes of late collection.

Nursery School Fees:

All eligible children can access their funded hours at no cost.

Funded hours are provided at no charge. The 'Funded Fee' columns reflect the cost of additional hours and voluntary extras for each booking pattern. Government funding only covers the cost of the provision of childcare and the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). The funding does not include any of the other services that our nurseries provide, which include, but are not limited to:

- Enrichment activities such as Little Kickers, Studio Cultivate, Blueberry Music, Tarka Sports, Eco Forest School
- Meals and snacks
- Nursery supplies, including crafting and educational materials

**All charges for the above are voluntary for children accessing funded hours. Parents may opt out of any or all.*

The fees above show the amount you would pay for your child's place if taking a combination of funded hours, voluntary extras, and sessions that are not covered by the Government funding.

Our voluntary extras are calculated as follows:

£5 per day for food and £72.50 per day for other consumables when attending mornings only.

£20 per day for food and £92.50 per day for other consumables when attending full days.

Extracurricular Activities:

These activities form part of our enrichment programme, running alongside the EYFS curriculum. Participation is optional. Children not taking part will follow our EYFS curriculum during these sessions.

Payment Information:

We request that all nursery school fees are paid before the start of term. Payment details and the amounts you will need to pay will be sent to you in an invoice through our parent app, as well as information on late payment charges should we need to apply them.

Tax-Free Childcare:

Tax-Free Childcare is a Government service to help working parents with the cost of their childcare. For every £8 a parent pays into their childcare account, the Government will pay an extra £2, up to a maximum of £2,000 every year for each child. Please visit
